

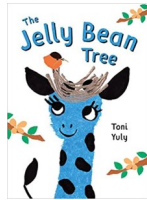
## BOOK CLUB MONDAYS

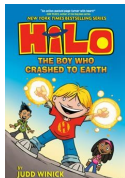
### Graphic Novel Book Club (Gr. 4-5)

TLC is a teen-led group that you can help design. Make your voice heard and make a difference. Let's start a new project that is meaningful to you.



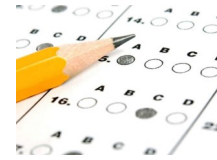
### C2 Education's SAT/ACT Practice Test
