- What's the difference between an assisted living and a nursing home?

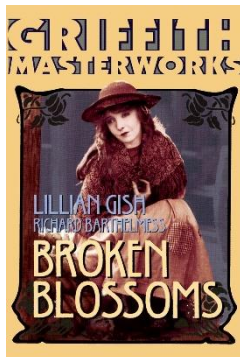
