

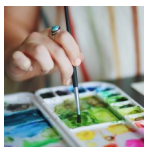

## BOOK CLUB MONDAYS

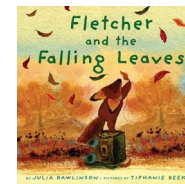
### Bookworm Crafters (Gr. K-1)
